LEVELS OF GIVING

\$50

- Two gas vouchers for patients to travel the often daily trips to treatment
- Meal vouchers for patients who remain in treatment for long periods of time each day
- 30 nutritional shakes for patients with cancers that make it challenging to eat solid foods
- 5 cases of water for patients receiving treatment

\$100

- A state-of-the-art, 3-D mammogram for a patient who does not have access to screening programs for breast cancer
- One night in local hotel accommodations near the Cancer Center to prevent multiple trips to and from Montgomery from their homes
- A lymphedema compression sleeve for patients impacted by lymph node removal during their cancer treatment
- Cover the cost of a low dose CT scan of the chest that could lead to early detection of lung cancer
- Gas voucher given to patients transported by friend/family member to Birmingham for specialist services or charitable dental care

\$250

- Mastectomy recovery bra and prosthetic breast for patients undergoing surgery
- A wig for patients whose hair thins or falls out during their treatment
- A mobility device such as a rolling walker to help patients move around and enjoy life in a safer way during and after treatment
- Estimated amount charged by private transportation companies when a friend/family member is not available

\$500

- Magnetic Resource Imaging—“MRI” for an underinsured or non-insured patient
- Provide snack food items and refreshments for patients undergoing treatments for a full month
- Stoma supplies for patients with colostomy, tracheostomy or urostomy—dressings, bags, etc.—specifically for Medicaid patients, neither supplies nor home health is covered
- Provide funding for community outreach programs for various types of cancer—skin, colorectal, breast, and lung

\$1,000

- Genetic Testing for a patient to understand the best treatment options for them or their family member and to understand their future risk of developing cancer
- Wheelchair to assist in transportation of patients throughout the Center during treatments and visits
- Provide a motorized scooter for a patient with long-term mobility issues related to their cancer diagnosis

\$2,500

- Doctors use PET—Positron Emission Tomography—imaging to measure the effectiveness of chemotherapy treatments in cancer patients; this level would cover the cost of this advanced imaging service for a patient who is under- or non-insured
- Waiting and treatment room enhancements to provide additional privacy for patients

\$5,000

- Purchase of a new, heated, medical-grade treatment recliner for patients receiving chemotherapy treatments
