LEVELS OF GIVING

\$50

Two gas vouchers for parents who often travel long distances or make multiple daily trips to visit their hospitalized infant

Meal vouchers for parents who often take only brief "meal breaks" between visits

Journals/pens for parents to document their "NICU journey" as emotional support

Two sets of isolette porthole wristlets which prevent heat/humidity from escaping from our specialized infant beds when parents are comforting their babies

One night stay in a local hotel accommodation near the NICU to prevent multiple trips to Montgomery

One specialized infant stethoscope, used daily by the NICU staff to assess these fragile newborns

Six specialized bathing systems for nurses' use when caring for NICU infants

\$250

Twelve infant developmental swaddling blankets for infants suffering from drug withdrawal

Provides heated warming mattresses used in the transport of six low birthweight and premature infants

\$500

Provides a developmental positioning system for twelve NICU babies

Testing fee and study guide for one NICU nurse to obtain their National Certification

\$1,000

Purchase of a hospital grade breastmilk warming system

Two new rocking chairs for parent use during NICU visitation

\$2,500

Purchase of an infant bassinet for the NICU patient who has reached four pounds

Purchase of a specialized NICU recliner for the purpose of parents performing "kangaroo care"

\$5,000

Purchase of a phototherapy system for the treatment of jaundice/hyperbilirubinemia

Purchase of an advanced/safety medication delivery system (medication syringe pump)
